




Japan has a long list of emperors, and the last emperor nowadays on Earth is in Japan. Which city did they choose as capital of their empire?

- **5**. Emperor Shomu moved the capital in 742 or 794. He didn't choose Fujiwara nor Heian.

- 6. The Yamato prefecture was chosen in 694 or 794.
- 7. The city of Heian isn't in Yamato, and it wasn't chosen in 781.
- **8.** Emperor Konin followed right after the emperor which moved the capital to Koka.
- 9. Fujiwara was chosen in 794 or by empress Jito.
- **10.** Kyoto and Niigata have been chosen consecutively somehow.
