




While returning from work, four drivers stopped at a gas station to fill their cars. How many gallons were filled by pump number 4?

- **1.** Exactly one of the drivers has the same initial in their name and in the color of their car.
- **2.** The second pump filled 2 gallons less than the first one, but 2 gallons more than Emma's station.
- **3.** Grace doesn't own a blue car, didn't fill 10 gallons, and wasn't served at the fourth station.
- **4.** The gray car was served at the pump previous to Emma's one.

- 5. Benjamin used the third pump or filled 12 gallons.
- **6.** The blue and black cars were filled with a total of 18 gallons.
- 7. The black car filled 10 gallons or it was on the third pump.
- 8. Benjamin wasn't at the fourth pump.
- 9. The second pump served 8 gallons or filled the black car.









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
