1. Only the monster in Washington has the same initial in its name and shape.
2. Only the shortest monster has the same initial in its name and in the city it is in.
3. The ant-like monster is Chaosus or is the 400 feet tall one.
4. Glasgow's menace isn't just 350 feet tall.
5. The giant scorpion is in Caracas or Glasgow.
6. The giant worm is 350 or 450 feet long.
7. Storvore is in Caracas or is the worm.
8. Gargatax isn't in Santiago, and isn't 500 feet tall.
9. The scorpion is Chaosus or Storvore.
