1. Exactly one of the aircrafts has the same initial in its name and in its nationality.
2. The Gribovsky was launched 2 years later than the Showa. Neither of them was French.
3. The Japanese aircraft was the number 88 or the L2D.
4. The Soviet vessel wasn't the Farman.
5. The Junkers wasn't the L2D, and it was released 2 years after the aircraft number 400.
6. Germany launched an aircraft in an odd year if and only if the Showa was launched in an even year.
7. Japan launched an aircraft in 1936 or in 1939.
8. The soviet aircraft was deployed five years after the German one.
9. German aircraft wasn't the number 11.
