Logic Grid Puzzle



During World War II, the belligerent nations deployed their best aircrafts. Find out which is the ID number of the German aircraft.

- Exactly one of the aircrafts has the same initial in its name and in its nationality.
- The Gribovsky was launched 2 years later than the Showa. Neither of them was French.
- The Japanese aircraft was the number 88 or the L2D.
- The Soviet vessel wasn't the Farman.
- The Junkers wasn't the L2D, and it was released 2 years after the aircraft number 400.
- Germany launched an aircraft in an odd year if and only if the Showa was launched in an even year.
- Japan launched an aircraft in 1936 or in 1939.
- The soviet aircraft was deployed five years after the German one.
- German aircraft wasn't the number 11.
