- The prize given in January was awarded one day before the prize awarded in March.
- Friederich won \$29,000 or he won on the 30th.
- Albert didn't play in February.
- The prize awarded in April was \$1,000 lower than the prize awarded in January.
- If Janet won in April, then Albert won \$27,000.
