- Exactly one of the bandits has the same initial in the county where he lived and in its forename or surname.
- Exactly one of the bandits has the same initial in the place where he ended his days, and in its forename or surname.
- The reward against Allison was immediately lower than the reward on Cassidy's head.
- Johnny Ringo was captured in Arizona or his bounty was \$ 500.
- The county of Lincoln issued a reward of \$ 500 or \$ 5000 against its bandit. The Cochise County didn't issue a bounty of \$ 3500.
- A total of \$ 6250 have been paid: one of the bandits fled without being captured.
- Billy the Kid was captured while he was in Bolivia or in New Mexico.
- Billy or Johnny lived in Lincoln.
- Two of the bandits have been captured in New Mexico and in Arizona. The third captured one was from Colfax.
- The bandit which lived in Cochise had higher bounty than the bandit from Colfax.
- Butch Cassidy didn't go to Texas.
