



Four artists exhibited their arts using very particular techniques at the national art contest. Knowing that the surfaces are displayed from the softest to the hardest, which tool did Monica use?

- Exactly one of the artists has the same initial in his/her name and his/her tool.
- A man used acrylics, a woman painted on paper.
- Oil colors were used on a less resistant surface than Frank's choice. Frank didn't use the sponge.
- Among the artist who used the tempera and the artist who painted on wood, one is Monica and the other used the brush.
- The sponge was used with acrylic or on cardboard.
- Andrew either used the spatula or painted on canvas.
- Watercolor was used on a harder surface than tempera.
- The aerograph is related to two items that both have the same initial.
